

ALUMNI TOUR FINAL ITINERARY

Tuesday, June 26: Rehearsal at the CAC in Morgantown

Wednesday, June 27: Departure from MORGANTOWN to BWI and flight to EUROPE via Iceland.

Thursday, June 28: ARRIVAL COPENHAGEN (Denmark)

Arrival in the airport of Copenhagen. Transfer to the hotel .
Balance of the day to relax. Accomodation at DGI Byens Hotel

Friday, June 29: COPENHAGEN

Breakfast is served. Start your day with a 6 hours guided tour of the city. During the tour you will see the Amalienborg Palace, Christiansborg Palace (seat of the Danish Parliament), Hans Christian Andersen's statue, Gefion Fountain, the old harbour of Nyhavn, the famous Little Mermaid and many other popular sights. Entrances included to Christiansborg and the beautiful Rosenborg Castle, built in 1633 of red brick decorated with sandstone.

Concert in Copenhagen.

Welcome dinner and accomodation at DGI Byens Hotel

Saturday, June 30: COPENHAGEN to GOTHENBURG (Sweden)

Breakfast is served. Leave Copenhagen by private charter coach. Cross the Öresund bridge to Malmö. Continue to Gothenburg.

Concert in Gothenburg. Dinner and accomodation at Quality Hotel

Sunday July 1: GOTHENBURG to OSLO (Norway) □

Breakfast is served. Drive from Gothenburg to Oslo. Dinner and accomodation at Rica Victoria Hotel Oslo

Monday, July 2: OSLO Breakfast is served .

In the morning you will meet your local guide for a 6 hours city sightseeing tour of Oslo by local coach. The tour includes a visit to the famous Vigeland sculpture park. You will also see the Royal castle, the City hall, the Parliament building (Stortinget) etc. Combine the city with a trip to the Bygdøy peninsula where you will visit the Viking ship museum and the Fram and Kon-tiki Museums. Take a trip to Holmenkollen for panoramic views of the city and fjord below.

Concert in Oslo. Dinner and accomodation Rica Victoria Hotel Oslo.

Tuesday, July 3: OSLO to BERGEN Breakfast is served .

Early morning departure from Oslo, driving past the beautiful Tyri Fjord and along the picturesque Halling Valley to the tourist resort town of Geilo. In Geilo board the train which will take you to Myrdal where you will change to the famous Flåm Railway. The 20 km stretch starts at Myrdal (altitude 866 m) and descends to Flåm (2 m above sea level). In Flåm board a sightseeing boat for a 2 hours cruise along the narrow Nærøy and Aurlands Fjords to Gudvangen. From the sun deck you can relax and enjoy the spectacular mountain scenery, waterfalls and wildlife of the fjords. In Gudvangen meet again with your coach and driver. Breathtaking ascent of the Stalheim Canyon, with impressive views of the Nærøy Valley with its mountain peaks and waterfalls. Continue to Bergen, capital of Western Norway and gateway to the fjords.

Dinner and accomodation at Comfort Hotel Holberg.

Wednesday, July 4: BERGEN to STAVANGER

Breakfast at the hotel. The day starts with a 2 hours sightseeing tour of Bergen. including a visit to the famous Fish and Flower Market, the old Bryggen Harbour with its gabled packhouses, the popular Hanseatic Quarter and the ancient Maria Church (from the outside) Drive from Bergen via Osøyro to Halhjem. 1-hour ferry crossing to Sandvikvåg, before you continue with the coach along the island Stord. From Skjersholmane you cross the new tunnel to Valevåg. Ferry crossing Arsvågen - Mortavik. Pass the tunnel to Randaberg, before you arrive in Stavanger. Stavanger is known as a trading centre for petroleum refinery and the building of oil platforms. In the city centre, close to the harbour and the cathedral you will find the original Stavanger with its narrow streets and white framehouses.

Concert either in Bergen or Stavanger.

Dinner and accomodation at Park Inn Stavanger Hotel.

Thursday, July 5: STAVANGER – KRISTIANSAND – HIRTSHALS - REBILD

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning 2 hours city tour of Stavanger with local English speaking guide. The tour goes through the city centre and includes a visit to the Old Stavanger. We pass the royal residence and manor house, Breidablikk, before continuing on to Hafrsfjord, past the monument the Three Swords, the symbol of the unification of Norway into one kingdom. Later we stop and enjoy the beautiful view from the Ullandhaugtårnet, from which you can see the city and all the way to Ryfylke. Stop also at the Stavanger cathedral dating from 1125. Leave Stavanger and drive south along the coast to the town of Kristiansand.

At 17.00 hrs: Departure on the Color Line ferry towards Denmark.

Dinner on board. Arrival in Hirtshals at 19.30 hrs. Continue south to Rebild, just south of Aalborg.

Accommodation at Comwell Rebild Bakker Hotel.

Friday, July 6: REBILD to COPENHAGEN (Denmark)

Breakfast at the hotel. Continue the tour driving south through Jutland and across Funen to Knudshoved where you will cross the Storebaelt Bridge to Sealand and Copenhagen.

Dinner and accomodation at DGI Byens Hotel

Saturday, July 7: DEPARTURE from COPENHAGEN for USA

Breakfast is served. Transfer to the airport. .End of services
