Who: West Virginia students (sophomores and above) enrolled in West Virginia colleges or universities (Alderson-Broadus College, Bluefield State College, Fairmont State University, Marshall University, Mountain State University, University of Charleston, West Liberty State College, West Virginia University, West Virginia Wesleyan College, and Wheeling Jesuit University) offering the bachelor's degree in nursing

What: \$500 per year

L.A. Toney Scholarship

Established more than 40 years ago

Who: Alternately, West Virginia State University and Bluefield State College students

What: \$500 per year

Application: Contact the financial aid office of the respective institution

Other: The scholarship is given in alternate years to Bluefield or W.Va. State. WVCEOS is notified of the recipient. For application, requirements, and other information, contact the financial aid office of the participating institutions

International Undergraduate Student Scholarship

Who: International undergraduate student enrolled or able to enroll at WVU

What: Cash award of \$3,500 and tuition waiver for a one-year, two-semester service learning opportunity

Application: Due March 1

Older 4-H Members' Conference Scholarship

Who: 12 4-H members eligible to go to Older 4-H Members' Conference

What: \$60 for each recipient to defray expenses at OMC

Application: None – selected from eligible campers by Jeffrey Orndorff (JDOrndorff@mail.wvu.edu)

Other: Awarded annually through the W. Va. 4-H Funds Committee of the WVU Foundation

Polly Spangler Maclin Scholarship

Who: A 4-H member at each Alpha Camp

What: \$100 is awarded to a deserving recipient

Application: None – selected from the eligible campers at Alpha Camps by the camp honors/recognition selection committee

Other: Awarded annually – the awardees are encouraged to report to their county CEOS councils and 4-H leaders association and relate "What the camp meant to me"

This scholarship recognizes Polly Maclin's significant contributions to West Virginia 4-H boys and girls and to home demonstration club work (now Community Educational Outreach Service)
