FFO4. Incident Safety Officer (ISO) & Health and Safety Officer (HSO) Train-the-Trainer

This NFA Train-the-Trainer course is designed to inform Instructors of the new updates and changes to the Incident Safety Officer & Health and Safety Officer. Instructors will be shown how to introduce the concepts of the Safety Officer's role at emergency responses. A specific focus on operations within an Incident Command System (ICS) as a Safety Officer is a main theme. Response to all hazardous types of situations will be emphasized. Pre-requisites: must have taken ISO/HSO. Copies of certificates must be provided before class.
