AWARD REQUIREMENTS

- This application is only applicable for students attending colleges in the U.S.
- Applicants must be members in **good standing** of The Fraternity of Phi Gamma Delta. A Fraternity Official will confirm your good standing, including all financial responsibilities at the end of the academic year.
- Applicants must have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale or equivalent to be considered. Official transcripts from any undergraduate institution attended must be submitted, including your final fall 2004 semester. Your transcript must be produced by the university and include your name.
- The application must be completed in full either typed or clearly printed. Completed applications must contain application, community service statement, financial need statement, copy of FAFSA, Award letter, and official transcript. Documents may be sent under separate cover, but each must be postmarked by midnight, April 4, 2005. Answer all questions where indicated on application form and do not use a separate piece of paper except when asked to attach a statement.
- The Purple Legionnaire is required to sign your application form. Only if the Purple Legionnaire position is vacant may a graduate member of the House Corporation or the BCA sign in place of the Purple Legionnaire.
- Acceptance of a Foundation scholarship imposes an obligation to begin and complete a year of full-time study (12 credit hours) in 2005-2006. Brothers graduating during the 2005-2006 academic year may be considered for a partial scholarship.
- All winners will be notified before the beginning of each school year.
- Most scholarships of \$1,000 will be distributed in two installment of half each, one for the first semester and one for the second semester to the scholarship recipient.

Each year, the Phi Gamma Delta Educational Foundation receives gifts from graduate Brothers who wish to help their undergraduate and graduate Brothers with educational pursuits. Scholarships generally are \$1,000 each and are awarded on the basis of need for financial assistance, scholarship, leadership, and citizenship.

The Foundation provides undergraduate scholarships as grants, not loans. Recipients are encouraged to do whatever they can, when they are financially able, to give to the Foundation so that it will continue to have the resources to grant such assistance to deserving Brothers in the future.
