

West Virginia University: CLA Administration

West Virginia University participated in the CLA for the 2009-2010 academic year. The university randomly selected 100 freshmen during the Fall 2009 term, and 100 Seniors during the Spring 2010 term. The students selected were broadly representative of their class—in terms of SAT, ACT, high school GPA, and chosen field of study.

Out of the 100 freshmen targeted 98 completed the assessment. Out of the 100 seniors targeted 88 completed the assessment.

Overall, the scores reflected a greater value added than what was expected. The assessment is valuable when determining if critical thinking skills increase as the student progresses through their respective college career.
