NOMINATION AND APPLICATION INFORMATION**

The COSO Advocacy Award was developed to recognize and honor persons who have provided outstanding service to WVU gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgendered students, staff, and/or faculty. This award recognizes not only service to others, but the courage and personal sacrifices this challenging work requires.

ELIGIBILITY

All students, faculty, and staff who have been or are currently involved in improving the social climate for gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgendered (GLBT) people at WVU are eligible to apply or be nominated for the award.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Service to and advancement of gay, lesbian, bisexual, and/or transgendered persons at WVU.
2. Significant advocacy, teaching, program development and/or scholarship which directly benefits the GLBT community.
3. Working to build coalitions between organizations committed to social justice for GLBT people.
4. Mentoring students, staff, or faculty who are GLBT at WVU.

The Council on Sexual Orientation will select the award recipient.
